

The Cable Academic and Vocational Education Center at Connecticut Junior Republic
Educational Continuity Plan during Covid-19 Pandemic Phase II

*During the Week of March 16th, all students received independent study portfolios based on their current individualized coursework, IEPs, skills, and interests. Effective **April 1, 2020**, the CAVEC Schools at CJR will be implementing Phase II of our Educational Continuity Plan. We will meet students' needs by ensuring that the following programs are in place:*

1. Academics

All students will be assigned an account at www.schoology.com in **Humanities** (English language arts and American Studies) and **STEM** (Science & Math). Their teachers will post learning objectives, activities, assignments, and assessments from our Synthesized Academic Curriculum. Students will interact with their teachers on a message dashboard, may ask questions and have questions answered, and upload assignments. All learning objectives will be aligned to each student's IEP, skill level, credit requirements, and personal interests.

2. Vocational & Experiential Learning

Students who are enrolled in our residential treatment programs will have the opportunity to continue to attend traditional classes daily. Day students who are employed and are able to go to work on a regular basis will receive high school credit for Work Study.

3. Related Services

Day students who receive counseling will be contacted by our LCSW to schedule weekly group meetings, individualized sessions, and parent discussions through Zoom. For students who are unable to access Zoom, we will conduct counseling via the telephone.

Day students who receive speech therapy will have their sessions scheduled on a case-by-case basis.

Residential students who receive counseling will continue to meet with their residential clinicians.

4. Transition & Alumni Services

All day students will be assigned a CJR email address so that they can receive information about colleges, post-secondary vocational schools, and employment opportunities. CJR faculty & staff will be available by email and phone to assist students with applications, financial aid, and identifying opportunities.

CJR will continue to provide regularly scheduled support for our alumni via phone, email, and Zoom and for other alumni who may need assistance.

5. PBIS & School Culture

CJR faculty & staff will call each day student and his or her parents weekly. We will also encourage students to communicate via CJR email with their teachers, staff members, and each other on a regular basis. We will continue to support the school community by celebrating birthdays and other milestones for each student via email.

CJR will continue to provide students and parents/guardians with a Weekly Progress Report via email.
